Choosing to Adopt: The Process

After visiting with the animals and deciding that you are ready to adopt, there are some things you need to do before you are ready to begin!

First, read the addendum that describes your prospective animal's needs and if they have any health issues. Be sure that you are ready for the responsibility that comes along with adopting.

Second, fill out an application and plan a counselor visit.

Once you have submitted the application an adoption counselor will review it in order to find the best fit between you and the animal.

Third, pay the adoption fee and begin your two-week trial. The trial period is when you and your animal adjust and get to know each other.

At the end of the trial period you can sign the final adoption papers!
